# CRAZY TRAIL

## Learning Objectives:

- To encourage children to work as a group
- To learn basic map reading skills
- To learn about the different trees on the Yew Trail

## Using the CRAZY TRAIL

- The Parachute is the start point
- A sign marked CRAZY TRAIL will instruct the group to proceed to a particular blue 'tree trail' number
- The group will use their maps to find the blue 'tree trail' numbered tree
- When the group reaches the 'tree trail' tree they will have to locate a box which will be placed on the ground alongside or very close to the tree trunk
- Inside the box will be the name of the tree the group have found and the number of the next tree to go to. There are 6 trees on the CRAZY TRAIL
- At each tree the teacher can use the 'tree trail' information cards to give the group information about the tree
- The group could collect a leaf from each tree or do a bark rubbing of each trunk to compare at the end
- Please leave each box and card where you found it so that the next group can enjoy the CRAZY TRAIL

## The Route
